Food Vendor Fees:

The cost for food vendor booths is as follows:

Providing Meals to 10 musicians:	\$200
(The committee will provide meal vouchers to the musicians)	
Not providing meals:	\$250
Extra power outlet:	\$25

Food Vendor Information and Requirements:

- Food vendors will be chosen by the festival committee; local businesses and the previous year's food vendors will be given priority. The committee will determine the number of food vendors at the Festival.
- Food vendors pay a \$200 fee and provide meals for 10 musicians. If the food booth sells items that could not provide a complete meal, then the vendor will be required to pay \$250. This fee will secure the vendor an area to prepare food and an area to sell their products. The vendor must provide tents and shade structures.
- The festival starts at 3PM on Friday. Food Vendors will have access to the venue starting at 10AM on the day of the festival. All vehicles should be off the field by 2:30PM. Each food vendor will be assigned a space on the field and will be provided an assigned parking space near their booth. Vendors are responsible for their booth, tables, chairs, lights, and canopy if one is desired.
- Food vendors will be provided with one 15-amp breaker. An additional 15-amp breaker can be purchased for \$25. Additional breakers are limited and will be assigned to the first vendors that apply. They can use this power to run cooking devices and lighting. Vendors are required to provide their own lighting for their booth. Vendors must provide their own power cords. It is recommended each vendor bring at least a 100ft power cord.
- Food vendors may sell non-alcoholic beverages, but **may not sell bottled water**. Water stations will be provided throughout the venue. The vendors may sell reusable water bottles with their logos.

- To emphasize the environmental aspects of the festival, food vendors may not use plastic or Styrofoam products. Please use “green products” such as paper and compostable plates and utensils.
- Food vendors will be provided the names of the other food vendors prior to the festival. We encourage communication between vendors in order to provide the festivalgoers with a wide variety of choices and prevent the vendors from selling the same items. Menus with pricing need to be provided to the vendor sub-committee so they can be posted on the Festival website. Our intention is to provide the festival attendees with a wide variety of fresh local fare and the menus will help us insure that there is a good mix of foods. Email menus to ccc@infowest.com.
- Due to requirements by the Town’s insurance carrier, all vendors must provide their own liability insurance and provide a certificate of liability as part of their application. Coverage must be at least \$1,000,000 per occurrence and certificate must name the Town of Springdale as an additional insured. www.actinspro.com has insurance available for as little as \$39.
- Lodging and Camping. No on-site camping at the festival grounds. Campgrounds are available in Springdale, Virgin, and Zion National Park.
